**SOLOMON ISLANDS INDEPENDENCE ORDER 1978**

(Legal Notice No. 43 of 1978)

**MEMBERS OF PARLIAMENT (ENTITLEMENTS) COMMISSION  
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2026**

The Members of Parliament (Entitlements) Commission, under section 69B(2) of the *Constitution*, make the following Regulations:

**1 Citation**

These Regulations may be cited as *The Members of Parliament (Entitlements) Commission (Amendment) Regulations 2026*.

**2 Commencement**

These Regulations commence on the date of publication in the *Gazette*.

**3 Amendment of the *Members of Parliament (Entitlements) Commission Regulations 1988***

This Regulations amends the *Members of Parliament (Entitlements) Commission Regulations* (Legal Notice No. 29 of 1988) (“**Principal Regulations**”).

**4 Regulation 9(2) repealed and substituted**

Regulation 9(2) of the *Principal Regulations* is repealed and substituted as

follows:

“(2) The constituency allowance specified in Appendix A7:

- (a) is payable in three instalments in each year at intervals of not less than 3 months; and
- (b) must not be treated as part of the basic salary of a Member.”.

**5 Regulation 11D(4) repealed and substituted**

Regulation 11D(4) of the Principal Regulations is repealed and substituted as follows:

“(4) If a Member becomes entitled to a pension arising from another public office, the payment of this pension ceases immediately.”.

**6 Regulation 33(2)(c) repealed and substituted**

Regulation 33(2)(c) of the Principal Regulations is repealed and substituted as follows:

“(c) The supply of phone credits for a prepaid mobile phone at a maximum rate of \$3,000 per month except the Prime Minister who is entitled to a maximum rate of \$3,500 per month.”.

**7 Regulations 35 to 58A renumbered**

Regulation 35 to 58A of the Principal Regulations are amended by renumbering regulation 35 as regulation 34, and each subsequent regulation is renumbered sequentially.

**8 Regulation 67 amended**

Regulation 67 of the Principal Regulations is amended:

- (a) by renumbering regulation 67 as regulation 64; and
- (b) by substituting “Regulation 34” for “Regulation 35” after “in accordance with”.

**9 Regulations 68 to 70 renumbered**

Regulations 68 to 70 of the Principal Regulations are amended by renumbering regulation 68 as regulation 65, and each subsequent regulation is renumbered sequentially.

**10 New regulation inserted after regulation 67**

The Principal Regulations is amended by inserting immediately after regulation 67 the following:

“68 The Commission may determine any entitlement matter not provided for in these Regulations, if the matter is within the scope of its functions under the *Constitution* and these Regulations.”.

**11 Appendix A amended**

Appendix A of the Principal Regulations is amended:

- (a) by repealing “1. **BASIC SALARY**” and the provisions under it and substituting as follows:

**“1. BASIC SALARY**

The following basic salary per annum is payable to the following:

(a) Prime Minister	\$454,659.43
(b) Deputy Prime Minister	\$408,687.10
(c) Ministers, Leader of Opposition and Leader of Independent Group	\$354,912.78
(d) Deputy Speaker and Chairperson of Parliamentary Standing Committees	\$320,279.37
(e) Members and	\$288,615.02”;

- (b) by substituting:

- (i) “[Reg. 58]” after “**3. CLOTHING ALLOWANCE**”, with “[Reg. 57]”; and
- (ii) “[Reg. 35]” after “**6. LOCAL TOURING ALLOWANCE**” with “[Reg. 34]”; and
- (iii) “[Reg. 51]” after “**8. SUBSISTENCE ALLOWANCE OVERSEAS**” with “[Reg. 50]”; and
- (iv) “[Reg. 69]” after “**10. MEMBERS OF PARLIAMENTARY STANDING SELECT COMMITTEES AND SPECIAL SELECT COMMITTEES**” with “[Reg. 64]”.
