SOLOMON ISLANDS INDEPENDENCE ORDER 1978

(L.N. 43 of 1978)

REVOCATION OF TEMPORARY ASSIGNMENT OF RESPONSIBILITIES TO THE MINISTER FOR ENVIROMENT, CLIMATE CHANGE, DISASTER MANAGEMENT, CONSERVATION AND METEOROLGY

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 37 of the *Constitution* and acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister, I, Sir David Tiva Kapu, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor-General and Commander-in-Chief of Solomon Islands, revoke the temporary assignment (G.N. No. 275 of 2026, page 202) to the person for the time being holding the office of:

MINISTER FOR ENVIRONMENT, CLIMATE CHANGE, DISASTER MANAGEMENT, CONSERVATION AND METEOROLOGY

for the responsibility for the administration of the Ministry of Infrastructure Development and for the conduct of the business of the Government of Solomon Islands, and the statutory authorities specified in the Schedule, on and from the date of this instrument.

**TEMPORARY ASSIGNMENT OF RESPONSIBILITIES TO THE MINISTER
FOR FISHERIES AND MARINE RESOURCES**
