**EMERGENCY POWERS ACT  
(CAP. 11)****EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID-19) (NO. 2) REGULATIONS 2020****EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID-19) (DECLARATION OF  
QUARANTINE STATIONS) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2020**

I, **Hon. Manasseh D. Sogavare**, Prime Minister, under regulation 6 of the *Emergency Powers (COVID-19) (No. 2) Regulations 2020* (Legal Notice No. 47 of 2020), and with reference to section 36 of the *Interpretation and General Provisions Act* (Cap. 85), make the following Order:

**1 Citation**

This Order may be cited as the Emergency Powers (COVID-19) (Declaration of *Quarantine Stations*) (*Amendment*) Order 2020.

**2 Commencement**

This Order commences on the date it is published in the *Gazette*.

**3 *Amendment to Emergency Powers (COVID-19) (Declaration of Quarantine Stations) Order 2020***

This Order amends the Emergency Powers (COVID-19) (Declaration of *Quarantine Stations*) Order 2020 (Legal Notice No. 35 of 2020) ("**Principal Order**").

**4 Principal Order Amended**

The Principal Order is amended by:

- (a) deleting “public places” (occurring twice) and substituting “properties”, and (b) deleting “public place” (occurring three times) and substituting “properties”. 5 **Schedule amended**

The Schedule to the Principal Order is amended by inserting after item no. 4 in the table:
