SOLOMON ISLANDS INDEPENDENCE ORDER 1978

(L.N. 43 of 1978)

TEMPORARY ASSIGNMENT OF RESPONSIBILITY TO THE MINISTER FOR TRADITIONAL GOVERNANCE, PEACE AND ECCLESIASTICAL AFFAIRS

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 37 of the Constitution and acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister, I, Sir David Tiva Kapu, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguish Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor-General and Commander-in-Chief of Solomon Islands, assign to the person holding the office of

MINISTER FOR TRADITIONAL GOVERNANCE, PEACE AND ECCLESIASTICAL AFFAIRS

responsibility for the administration of the Ministry of Finance and Treasury and for the conduct of the business of the Government of Solomon Islands as specified in the Schedule on and from the date this instrument is published in the gazette until the substantive Minister resumes his duties.
