SOLOMON ISLANDS INDEPENDENCE ORDER 1978 (LN. NO. 43 of 1978)

APPOINTMENT OF SOLOMON ISLANDS PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE TO THE UNITED NATIONS, WORLD TRADE ORGANISATION, UNITED NATIONS CONFERENCE ON TRADE AND DEVELOPMENT, INTERNATIONAL TRADE CENTRE, WORLD HEALTH ORGANISATION, INTERNATIONAL LABOUR ORGANISATION, INTERNATIONAL TELECOMMUNICATION UNION, WORLD METEOROLOGICAL ORGANISATION AND WORLD INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY ORGANISATION

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 127(1) of the Constitution, and in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister after consultation with the Public Service Commission, I, **SIR FRANK UTU OFAGIORO KABUI**, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Cross of the Order of Solomon Islands, Officer of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Governor-General and Commander-in-Chief of Solomon Islands, do hereby appoint –

BARRETT SALATO

to be Solomon Islands Permanent Representative to the United Nations, World Trade Organisation, United Nations Conference on Trade and Development, International Trade Centre, World Health Organisation, International Labour Organisation, International Telecommunication Union, World Meteorological Organisation and World Intellectual Property Organisation for a period of three (3) years with effect from 9th August, 2018.
