DANGEROUS DRUGS (METHYLAMPHETAMINE) RULES 2025

I, Hon. Dr. Paul Popora Bosawai, Minister for Health and Medical Service, under section 15, Proclamation (LN 101 of 1987) and Proclamation (LN 6 of 1988) of the *Dangerous Drugs Act* (Cap.98) make the following Rules:

1 Citation

These Rules may be cited as the *Dangerous Drugs (Methylamphetamine) Rules 2025*.

2 Commencement

These Rules commence on the date of publication in the *Gazette*.

3 Definitions

In these Rules:

“**Act**” means the *Dangerous Drugs Act* (Cap. 98);

“**distribution**” means the passing on of methylamphetamine from one person to another or from one location to another including:

- (a) the supply of raw materials and chemicals; or
- (b) small or large scale selling; or
- (c) transporting or moving around of methylamphetamine;

“**manufacture**” means the mixing or preparing of raw materials or chemicals for the production of methylamphetamine;

“**possession**” means having any amount of methylamphetamine on someone including:

- (a) on body, clothing, bag or purse; or
- (b) at an office or work station; or
- (c) in a vehicle or other owned transport; or
- (d) in a building or a home; or
- (e) any owned location;

“supply” means providing methylamphetamine to another person including:

- (a) systematic passing of or providing methylamphetamine from one person to another or from one location to another; or
- (b) providing raw material or chemical for production of methylamphetamine; or
- (c) small or large scale selling of methylamphetamine.

4 Possession prohibited

A person who is in possession of methylamphetamine without a licence or in contravention of the provisions of the Act or the *Pharmacy and Poisons Act* (Cap.105), commits an offence.

5 Supply and distribution prohibited

A person who supplies or distributes methylamphetamine without a licence or in contravention of the provisions of the Act or the *Pharmacy and Poisons Act* (Cap. 1 05), commits an offence.

6 Manufacturing and production prohibited

A person who manufactures or prepares for manufacturing methylamphetamine without a licence or in contravention of the provisions of the Act or the *Pharmacy and Poisons Act* (Cap.105), commits an offence.

7 Penalty and proceedings

A person who commits an offence under these Rules are subject to the penalties, proceedings and all relevant provisions of the Act.
