REGULATIONS 2010****NOTICE TO HOLD PROVINCIAL ELECTION IN MAKIRA
ULAWA PROVINCE**

IN exercise of powers conferred on me by section 9 and 10 of the Provincial Government Act 1997, as read with Regulation 9 of the *Provincial Government (Election) Regulations 2010*, I, Hon. David Tome, Minister for Provincial Government and Institutional Strengthening, hereby –

- (i) appoint the **16th day of December 2015** as the date for holding of the Provincial Assembly election in Makira Ulawa Province;
- (ii) appoint **Mr. Gilbert Tabihau** to be the Returning Officer for the Makira Ulawa Provincial election;
- (iii) require that all nominations in respect of candidates for the election be delivered to the Returning Officer at the Provincial Headquarters in Kirakira, Makira Ulawa Province, **not later than 4.00 o'clock on Wednesday 18th November 2015.**

**NOTICE TO CHANGE THE DATE OF THE PROVINCIAL
ELECTION IN MAKIRA ULAWA PROVINCE**

WHEREAS the ordinary election of members to the Makira Ulawa Provincial Assembly would normally be held on 22 December 2015, being the four year anniversary of the previous ordinary election;

WHEREAS 22 December 2015 falls on a Monday and at a time when many workers will be unavailable due to the Christmas holidays;

NOW THEREFORE I, Honourable David Tome, Minister for Provincial Government and Institutional Strengthening, being satisfied that such an action is necessary and in the public interest and having consulted with the Premier for Makira Province, do order pursuant to section 9(1) (b) of the Provincial Government Act 1997, that the ordinary election of members to the Makira Ulawa Provincial Assembly be held on **Wednesday 16 December 2015**.
