## **CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICES**

## (TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICE) ACT (Cap. 84)

As in force at: 20 September 2005

### 1 Short title

This Act may be cited as the Constitutional Offices (Terms and Conditions of Service) Act.

### 2 Salaries

The Minister may by order prescribe the annual or daily salary, as the case may be, that shall be paid to the holder of an office specified in the Schedule.

## 3 Regulations

The Minister may make regulations in respect of the terms and conditions of service (including housing and transportation) to which the holder of an office specified in the Schedule is entitled.

## 4 Payments charged on Consolidated Fund

All payments required by virtue of the provisions of this Act shall be charged and defrayed out of the Consolidated Fund.
