EXEMPTION ORDER

I, WALTON NAEZON, the Minister for Commerce, Industries and Employment, in exercising the powers conferred on me by section 79 of the Labour Act, exempt from section 37 of that Act non-indigenous workers employed by Kitano Construction Corporation who are working in Solomon Islands on the airport restoration project, subject to the condition that the exemption has effect in respect of each such non-indigenous worker only while he is working for Kitano Construction Corporation on the airport restoration project.
