**THE FISHERIES ACT 1998
(No. 6 of 1998)****THE FISHERIES (PROHIBITION OF EXPORT OF DOLPHINS)
REGULATION 2005**

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 59 of the Fisheries Act, 1998, I, MATHIAS TARO, Minister of Fisheries and Marine Resources, do hereby make the following regulation -

1. This Regulation may be cited as the Fisheries (Prohibition of Export of Dolphins) Regulation 2005, and shall come into effect on the date of publication in the gazette.

2. (1) The export of any dolphins of the *genera, stenell, Tursips, Peponocephala, Lagernodelphis, Grampus and Pseudorca* is hereby prohibited.

(2) Any person who contravenes the provisions of paragraph (1) shall be guilty of an offence and shall on conviction be liable to a fine not less than one hundred thousand dollars or to imprisonment for 6 months, or to both such fine and imprisonment.
