### PRESCRIPTION OF MINISTERS ACT (Cap. 91)

#### 1 Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Prescription of Ministers Act*.

#### 2 Number of Ministers

For the purposes of section 33(2) of the *Constitution* the prescribed number of Ministers (in addition to the Prime Minister) shall not exceed eighteen.
